To enable us to do this we would like to ask for some help and support. We are collecting a range of good quality materials that we feel would benefit and develop our outdoor provision and many of these resources are items that can often be found unused, in cupboards, garages, garages and sheds at home.

Below is a list of materials that we are collecting and, we ask kindly that if you have any 'unused' or 'spare' items from this list, would you please be willing to donate them to our pupils so that together we can create special outdoor experiences for our pupils to learn from and enjoy.

The items that would benefit our learners are:

- sieves and colanders
- saucepans
- measuring spoons
- mixing bowls
- large spoons, ladles, sieving spoons, tongs
- funnels
- plastic jugs
- plastic egg cups
- plungers
- buckets - all sizes
- plastic bath toys (that measure and pour)
- decorator's brushes
- decorator's rollers and trays
- ice cube trays

- sponges
- handheld plastic mirrors
- guttering pipes and attachments
- various lengths of hose
- hose with spray attachment
- baskets and containers
- plastic crates
