## Arrangements to reopen September 2022

Dear parents and carers,

Welcome back!

I am very proud to be able to write my first letter as Acting Head of Ysgol Gymraeg Parc Y Tywyn. I am very aware of the responsibility that I and my staff have to ensure that the highest standard of teaching and learning continues here in all areas. I am already very familiar with the pupils, staff, parents and governors and I feel privileged to be able to lead our school community over the next term.

I would like to thank Mr Davies for his help in ensuring that the transition period to Acting Head was as smooth as possible.

In terms of re-opening arrangements, the school will reopen to the pupils on Tuesday, September 6th 2022.

School starts at 9.00am and finishes at 3.20pm for Full-time Nursery children to Year 3 and at 3:25 for Year 4 to 6 children. Times for Part-time Nursery children are 9:00-11:30. Please see separate letter for collection point arrangements.

The school gates will open at 8.50am for each school year and staff will be at the gates to welcome the children. The Full Time Nursery to Year 6 children will enter through the main gate and Part Time Nursery through the reception. Parents are not able to come through the gates in the morning.

The Free Breakfast Club (8.15am) will continue. We ask that you fully consider whether you need a place as it could mean that families who really need a place could be missing out! Doors to the breakfast club (the outer door of the hall) will open at 8:15 and close at 8:30am. You will be required to fill in a form for your child to continue to use breakfast club. Forms will be given out by breakfast club staff.

Although the Covid restrictions have reduced, as a school we will continue to encourage the pupils to wash their hands often - soap and water or disinfection. We will continue to open the windows / doors to get enough fresh air in the rooms.

No child will leave the school until a parent is there to collect them. Only Year 5 and 6 children will be allowed to walk from school without an adult once the parent has filled in a form to give permission.
