IMPORTANT information regarding updated TTP procedures

What happens if my child or anyone in the household has COVID 19?

Dear parent / carer,

Our main priority is to keep our children, staff and the whole school community as safe as possible. The measures we have in place are there to help us do that. There are some changes with regards to the TTP procedures you should follow. Please read these carefully and ensure you comply with the following to help protect the whole school community.

If you OR your child or anyone else living in your household has any of the Covid-19 symptoms – **new persistent cough, fever and/or loss of taste or smell** – then that person must not attend school but stay at home, self-isolate and arrange a PCR test by phoning 119 or using the online portal.

You must contact **Delta Wellbeing on 0300 333 2222** or email **TTP@deltawellbeing.org.uk** providing your child's name, year group and school. You should also notify the school. This person should continue to isolate until you have received your test result.

Anyone who tests positive for Covid-19, whether from a lateral flow or a PCR test must continue to self-isolate and not attend school, as before. Despite this, **the following key changes will be in force from the start of the new term (September 2021):**

- Identified contacts of a proven case of Covid-19 who are under the age of 18 or those who are fully vaccinated will no longer have to self-isolate unless they themselves start to show symptoms of Covid-19. TTP contact tracers will contact the proxy (positive case) and get in touch with identified close contacts and offer them PCR testing on day 2 (or as soon as possible once identified as a contact) and day 8. TTP will also advise them on the most appropriate actions for their circumstances and for some, this will include advising them to self-isolate. The majority of learners in a class/year group are unlikely to be identified as close contacts. There will be no requirement for schools to routinely identify contacts of a positive case unless they are contacted by TTP.
- There is **NO** requirement for anyone awaiting a PCR test result as a contact to self-isolate. They (including siblings of a positive case) can continue to attend school as normal unless advised otherwise by TTP, unless they are experiencing any symptoms, or they have tested positive from a LFT, in which case they have a duty to self-isolate.

Please remember:

- Only one parent to drop-off/collect children
- Wear face coverings (unless exempt)
- Leave as soon as you have dropped off/collected your children
- Maintain a minimum of 2m social distance from other adults including staff
- Do not attend school if self-isolating or if you have any symptoms
