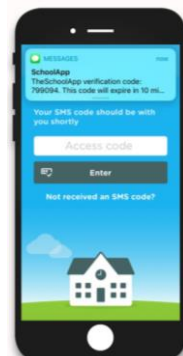

Blwyddyn diwethaf, buom yn brysur yn diweddarau gwefan newydd ein hysgol. Ewch i www.ysgolparcytywyn.co.uk. Er mwyn datblygu ein cysylltiadau â chi ymhellach, ac er mwyn eich diweddarau ar newyddion a digwyddiadau, fedrwch chi nawr lawrlwytho ap yr ysgol i'ch ffôn. Mae 'TheSchoolApp' yn cael ei bweru gan ein gwefan, sy'n eich galluogi i gael y wybodaeth ddiweddaraf am newyddion a digwyddiadau yr ysgol o'ch dyfais symudol. Mae'r app yn bersonol i'r ysgol ac mi fydd yn ein galluogi ni i gadw mewn cysylltiad a chi a'ch hysbysu. Mae 'TheSchoolApp' AM DDIM i chi ei lawrlwytho. Y cam cyntaf yw i lawrlwytho 'TheSchoolApp' ar eich ffôn.

Rydym yn annog pob rhiant i lawrlwytho'r ap. Ein nod yw i fod yn ysgol 'ddi-bapur' o ran yr ohebiaeth a ddosbarthwn i rieni. Pan fyddwn yn ddiweddarau ein app gyda unrhyw wybodaeth newydd mi fyddwch yn derbyn hysbysiad awtomatig i'ch dyfais. Byddwn yn defnyddio'r ap i'ch hysbysu am wybodaeth bwysig yn ogystal â negeseuon defnyddiol (e.e. diwrnodau cau, taith ysgol yn hwyr yn ôl oherwydd traffig, nodiadau atgoffa ac ati). Yn sgil yr hinsawdd sydd ohoni, mae'n bywsig bod pob rhiant yn lawrlwytho yr ap er mwyn derbyn gwybodaeth a newyddion diweddaraf yr ysgol.



Sut i lawrlwytho:

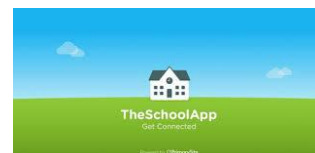
1. Ewch i'r farchnad berthnasol i'ch dyfais (Apple store neu Google Play)
2. Chwiliwch am The School App
3. Unwaith rydych wedi ei lawr wlytho, dewiwch Ysgol Parc y Tywyn
4. Unwaith gwelwch enw'r ysgol, dewiswch yr ysgol
5. Cadarnhewch eich dewis
6. Mi fydd yn gofyn os ydych wedi derbyn cod. Gwasgwch ydw. Bydd cod yn ymdangos i chi i roi i fewn.

Download our new school App to your mobile to keep up to date

Last year, we were busy updating our new school website. Please visit www.ysgolparcytywyn.co.uk. In order to further develop our links with yourselves and in order to keep you posted on news and events, you are now able to download the school app on to your phone. 'TheSchoolApp' is powered by our website, which allows you to stay up to date with the school's latest news and events from your mobile device. The app is personal to the school and it will enable us to keep in touch and notify parents of all school activities. TheSchoolApp is FREE for you to download. The first step is to get TheSchoolApp on your phone.

We encourage all parents to download the app. We aim to become 'paperless' with regards to the correspondence we distribute to parents. Every time the app is updated, you will receive an automatic notification to your device. We will also use the app to let you know important information as well as helpful reminders (eg. closure days, school trip late back due to traffic, reminders etc). In light of the current climate, it is imperative that all parents download the app in order to receive the latest information and news from the school!



How to download the app

1. Visit the appropriate marketplace for your device (Apple store or Google Play)
2. Search for TheSchoolApp
3. Once downloaded, search for the schools name
4. Once you see the school name, select YGG Parc y Tywyn
5. Confirm your selection
6. It will then ask if you have received a code. Select yes and a code should appear for you to input.

We will only be using this service to share correspondence with you from now on ie we will not be sending letters home with pupils!

Gorchuddion wyneb

Yn dilyn cyhoeddiad Mark Drakeford Dydd Gwener (<https://gov.wales/further-constraints-meeting-socially-and-compulsory-face-coverings-help-prevent-new-coronavirus>) y mae pob ysgol wedi derbyn arweiniad wedi'i ddiweddarau gan yr Awdurdod Lleol ynglŷn â gwisgo gorchuddion wyneb mewn ysgolion cynradd. O ddydd Llun 14/09 / 2020-

- Bydd gofyn i staff wisgo gorchuddion wyneb mewn rhannau o'r ysgol lle na ellir cwrdd â gofynion pellter cymdeithasol e.e. coridorau ac ystafelloedd staff
- Wrth i chi i ollwng a chasglu'ch plentyn efallai y byddwch chi'n sylwi ar staff yn gwisgo gorchuddion wyneb. Mae hyn er mwyn helpu i sicrhau bod rheolau pellter cymdeithasol yn cael eu cynnal gan oedolion ac i gadw pawb yn ddiogel. Byddwch yn ymwybodol nad oes unrhyw ofyniad ar hyn o bryd i staff wisgo gorchuddion wyneb pan fyddant yn yr ystafell ddosbarth. Yn ogystal, nid yw'n ofynnol i ddisgyblion wisgo gorchuddion wyneb.

Rydym yn annog rhieni ac oedolion i ddangos agweddau ac ymddygiad cadarnhaol tuag at orchuddion wyneb ar dir yr ysgol. O dan yr hinsawdd sydd ohoni, byddem yn annog rhieni i wisgo gorchuddion wyneb wrth ollwng a chasglu disgyblion. Hoffwn atgoffa pawb hefyd i barhau i barchu ac i gadw at y canllawiau pellhau cymdeithasol 2m cywir bob amser.

Face coverings

Following Mark Drakeford's announcement Friday (<https://gov.wales/further-constraints-meeting-socially-and-compulsory-face-coverings-help-prevent-new-coronavirus>) all schools have received updated guidance from the Local Authority regarding the wearing of face coverings in primary schools. As of Monday 14/09/2020-

- Staff will be required to wear face coverings in areas of the school where social distancing requirements cannot be met e.g. corridors and staff rooms
- On arrival to drop off and collect your child you may notice staff wearing face coverings. This is to help ensure that social distancing rules are maintained by adults and to keep everybody safe. Please be aware that at present, there is no requirement for staff to wear face coverings when in the classroom. In addition to this, there is no requirement for pupils to wear face coverings.

We are encouraging parents and adults to demonstrate positive attitudes and behaviours towards face coverings when on school grounds and in the wider community. Under the current climate, we would actively encourage parents to wear a face coverings when dropping off and collecting pupils. May I also remind everyone to continue to respect and exercise the correct 2m social distancing guidance at all times.

Clwb becwast

Bydd yn rhaid gwneud newidiadau i'r ffordd y mae'r Clwb Becwast Am Ddim (CBDd) yn cael ei redeg. Y brif her yw sicrhau bod disgyblion yn eu swigod dosbarth bob amser ac felly, am y tymor yma, bydd yn rhaid cael uchafswm o 12 disgybl i bob dosbarth. Bydd yr CBDd yn ailagor ar Fedi 21ain a bydd ar gael i ddisgyblion o'r Dosbarth meithrin llawn amser i Flwyddyn 6. Mae'r Clwb Becwast Am Ddim yno ar gyfer teuluoedd sy'n ei chael hi'n anodd darparu becwast i'w plant. Fodd bynnag, yn yr amseroedd anodd hyn, rydym wedi cytuno y dylai plant gweithwyr allweddol fod yn bresennol hefyd. Mae ansicrwydd o ran sut y bydd yr ychydig fisoedd nesaf yn datblygu, felly, mae'n bwysig bod gan yr ysgol fodel gweithio a fydd yn caniatáu iddi fynd i mewn i glo llawn neu rannol os bydd yr angen yn codi.

Felly, bydd lleoedd yn y CBDd yn cael eu dyrannu yn y drefn feini prawf ganlynol (i gynnwys brodyr a chwiorydd) –

- 1) Disgyblion sy'n gymwys i gael Prydau Ysgol Am Ddim (PYD)
 - 2) Disgyblion sydd ar restr fregus yr ysgol
 - 3) Plant Gweithwyr Allweddol - Iechyd, Gofal, Ysgolion (y rhai sydd eisoes wedi'u defnyddio ein darpariaeth HWB cyn yr Haf) - enwau wedi'u tynnu allan o het os yw'r niferoedd yn uwch na'r uchafswm dosbarth.
- Byddwn yn croesawi cymwysiadau newydd os caniateir lle.

Gofynnwn i chi ystyried yn llawn a oes angen lle arnoch gan y gallai olygu y gallai teuluoedd sydd wir angen lle fod ar eu colled! Archebu Lle -Bydd rhaid gwneid cais am yr hanner tymor hwn trwy sganio'r cod QR. Byddwch yn derbyn e bost

erbyn diwedd yr wythnos i gadarnhau / gwrthod lle i'ch plentyn am yr hanner tymor. Ni all unrhyw blant fynychu Clwb brecwast oni bai eich bod wedi derbyn e bost i gadarnhau lle. Bydd drysau i'r clwb brecwast yn agor am **8:15 ac yn cau am 8:30yb**. Bydd y trefniadau uchod yn parhau am y tymor a chânt eu hadolygu yn rheolaidd.

Breakfast Club

Changes have to be made to the way that the Free Breakfast Club (FBC) is run. The main challenge is to ensure that pupils are in their class bubbles at all times and therefore, for this term, there will have to be a limit of 12 pupils per class. The FBC will reopen on September 21st and will be available to pupils in full time nursery to Year 6. The Free Breakfast Club is there for families who are finding it difficult to provide breakfast for their children. However, in these difficult times, we have agreed that key worker children should also attend. There is uncertainty in how the next few months will pan out, therefore, it's important that the school has a working model that will allow it to go into full and partial lockdown if the need arises.

Therefore, places in the FBC will be allocated in the following order of criteria (to include siblings) -

- 1) Pupils who are eligible for Free School Meals (FSM)
- 2) Pupils who are on the school's vulnerable list
- 3) Keyworker children - Health, Care, Schools (those who used the HUB key worker provision before the Summer holidays) - names drawn out of a hat if numbers exceeds the class limit.

New applications will be considered if there are spaces available.



We ask that you fully consider whether you need a place as it could mean that families who really require a place could lose out. Booking a place –You will need to book places for the half term through scanning this QR code. You will then receive a letter by the end of the week to confirm or decline a place for your child to attend the FBC for this half term. No pupils will be permitted entry unless you have received an email confirming a place in breakfast club. Doors for the breakfast club will open at **8:15am and close at 8:30am**. The above arrangements will be in place for the term and will be reviewed regularly.

CINIO YSGOL

Bydd ciniawau ysgol yn aildddechrau ddydd Llun y 14eg o Fedi. Cofiwch fod angen archebu a thalu drwy Prent Pay - £2.50 y pryd. Bydd angen i chi archebu pryd o fwyd eich plentyn ymlaen llaw erbyn 8:00yb ar y diwrnod y mae angen pryd o fwyd ar eich plentyn neu, fel arall, gallwch archebu ymlaen llaw am yr wythnos cyfan. Os nad ydych wedi gwneud hynny eisoes, gwnewch yn siŵr eich bod wedi cofrestru eich cyfrif Parent Pay.

SCHOOL DINNERS School dinners will resume on Monday the 14th of September. Please order and pay in the usual way through Parent Pay - £2.50 per meal. Remember you must pre order your child's meal by 8:00am on the day your child requires a meal or alternatively you can book ahead for the week. If you have not already done so, please ensure you have registered your Parent Pay account.

BI 5 a 6 : Ffurflen caniatad i gerdded adref

Er mwyn sicrhau diogelwch plant, dim ond plant yn BLWYDDYN 5 a 6 sy'n cael cerdded adref ar eu pennau eu hunain ar ddiwedd y diwrnod ysgol.

Nid yw hyn yn golygu bod pob plentyn ym Mlwyddyn 5 a 6 yn barod i gerdded adref ar ei ben ei hun. Mae angen i rieni ystyried oedran, aeddfedrwydd ac annibyniaeth eu plentyn, ynghyd â'u pellter o'r ysgol a diogelwch y llwybr cyn gwneud penderfyniad ynghylch a yw'n ddiogel i bob plentyn gerdded adref ar ei ben ei hun ai peidio.

Os yw eich plentyn am gario ffôn symudol gyda nhw, gwnewch yn siŵr eu bod yn rhoi'r ffon i'w athro ar ddechrau'r dydd a'i gasglu ar ddiwedd y dydd. Nid yw'r ysgol yn derbyn unrhyw gyfrifoldeb am ffonau symudol a'r dir yr ysgol.

Er mwyn diogelu'r holl bobl ifanc yn YGG Parc y Tywyn, os ydych chi am gymryd cyfrifoldeb am i'ch plentyn wneud ei ffordd ei hun adref o'r ysgol, bydd angen caniatâd rhiant / gofalwr arnom i gadarnhau'r trefniant hwn.

Os hoffech i'ch plentyn gerdded adref ar ei ben/ ei phen ei hun, bydd angen i chi i sganio'r cod QR a chwblhewch y manylion.

RHAID cwblhau'r ffurflen hon cyn y gall plant gerdded adref ar eu pen eu hunain. Llenwch y ffurflen erbyn dydd Mercher 16.09.2020. Caniateir i ddisgyblion gerdded adref ar eu pennau eu hunain o ddydd lau 17.09.

Mae angen i bob plentyn arall gael ei gasglu gan oedolyn (nid yw'n briodol i frawd neu chwaer hŷn yng Nghyfnod Allweddol 2 eu cerdded adref).

Years 5 and 6 : Consent to walk home alone

In order to ensure children's safety, only children in YEAR 5 AND 6 are allowed to walk home on their own at the end of the school day.

This does not mean that all children in Year 5 and 6 are ready to walk home on their own. Parents need to consider their child's age, maturity and independence, as well as their distance from school and the safety of the route before making

a decision about whether or not it is safe for each child to walk home on their own.

If your child will be carrying a mobile phone with them, please ensure they hand it into their teacher at the beginning of the day and collect it at the end of the day. The school accepts no responsibility for mobile phones brought into school.

To safeguard all young people in YGG Parc y Tywyn School, if you wish to take responsibility for your child making their own way home from school then we will require permission from a parent/carer confirming this arrangement.

If you would like your child to walk home alone, please scan the QR code and complete the form. This form **MUST** be completed before children can walk home alone. Please complete form by Wednesday 16.09.2020. Pupils will be allowed to walk home on their own as of Thursday 17.09.



All other children need to be collected by an adult (it is not appropriate for an older sibling in Key Stage 2 to walk them home).
