- Learn to spell common words - there is a list of the 200 most common words on the Website and you can use Spellblast on J2Blast to do this. - Regular reading – remember to discuss what you have read, describe characters, explain events, sequence events, re-tell the story in your own words, use a dictionary/online dictionary to search for the meaning of unfamiliar vocabulary.	- Practice times tables (Don't forget you can also use TTblast within J2Blast to practise tables) Year 3 - 2, 3, 4, 5 and 10 Year 4 - 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8 and 10 - Adding and subtracting Year 3 to use 2 digit numbers eg $67 + 45 =$ / $86 - 34 =$ Year 4 to use 3 digit numbers eg $467 + 382 =$ - Recognise and count money, pay for items in different ways. - Tell the time to nearest 5 minute, then every minute	<u>Keep active</u>- what about joining Joe Wicks' live fitness sessions 9:00 – 9:30am on Youtube (with parental supervision) <u>Help</u> - what about helping around the house? ★ You are going to meet one of the heroes of the community. Create a questionnaire with a set of questions to ask them. Remember, you want to learn about his job, not personal things about them.	★ Create your own emergency hospital on squared paper. Next, create your own addition and subtraction sums on each square. There are only 6 answers with a special colour for each one. Please see the example - a mosaic fire engine.	★ Create a fire escape plan for your house. Design a simple diagram of your house and label it.
★★ Write a story beginning, or including, the sentence 'And then I heard the sound of the siren' Remember to use Pie Corbett's story vocabulary and time sequence words.	★★ There are many people who help us when there is an emergency! Create a square paper maze for each table, counting in 2, 5, 10, 4, 3, and 8. Next write out the multiplication table to match each one. See example Maze-10 Times table.	★★ Read the information Powerpoint about the RNLI on the school website. Create a model of an RNLI boat and place it in water. Consider the materials you choose and the shape carefully. Which materials float best and why?
★★★ Write a newspaper article to describe an emergency. Remember to give the article a title, a picture, a description of what happened and how the Emergency Services solved the problem.	★★★ Create your own maths word problems. Remember to create a situation with an emergency and to multiply, add and subtract. E.g 6 fire engines crash into park. There are 4 fire sounds in each. How many fires are there in total? What's your answer?	★★★ Look at 'First Aid Challenge' in our page on the school website under 'Fortnightly Challenges'. Complete the "Staying Safe" activity.
