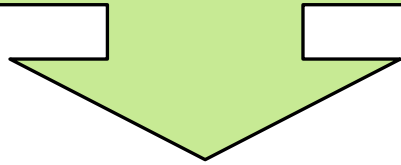


The Challenge:

Theme



Can you think of words that are associated with Winter e.e. eira(snow) Dyn eira (Snowman) Ia (ice) Robin Goch. Can you draw a picture of these and copy/write the correct words under each picture with support/independently.



Can you use different shapes to create a Snowman? Can you name these shapes? Can you make a set of Snowmen-big, medium and small? Go ahead and arrange these Snowmen-starting with the largest.



Get an adult to help you visit the Cyw website. Listen and sing along with the song Dawns y Plu Eira. Can you think of interesting movements to go with the song. Can you perform the song to other members of your family?



Can you create a list of suitable winter clothing e.g. woolly hat, scarf, warm jumper/coat/ gloves and wellies. Discuss your favourite item of winter clothing with an adult.



With an adult, collect data on which birds visit your garden/ you see in your street / in your village e.g. How about creating your own simple graph?



Can you draw/paint/ create a collage of a Snow man to display in the house? What about using recycling materials to create your collage. What about using an empty milk carton to make a Snow man?



Can you go on a letter hunt? How many things can you see in your garden beginning with the letters m, a, c, p, t, d, i, n, o, l, b, f, h, e, s? Can you form one or more of these letters? Can you spell some simple words using these letters e.g. mam, mat, mop, tap etc.



Day and Night- Some animals which live in Arctic sleep during the day and hunt for food during the night. Can you draw a picture of your day and night? Can you discuss what happens in your house during the day and night? What is your favourite routine during the day/night?



With an adult, go ahead and make some suitable food for the cold and hungry little birds. Remember to hang the food in a safe place. After making and hanging the food, how about taking some photos of the birds enjoying your food - share these with us on HWB.
