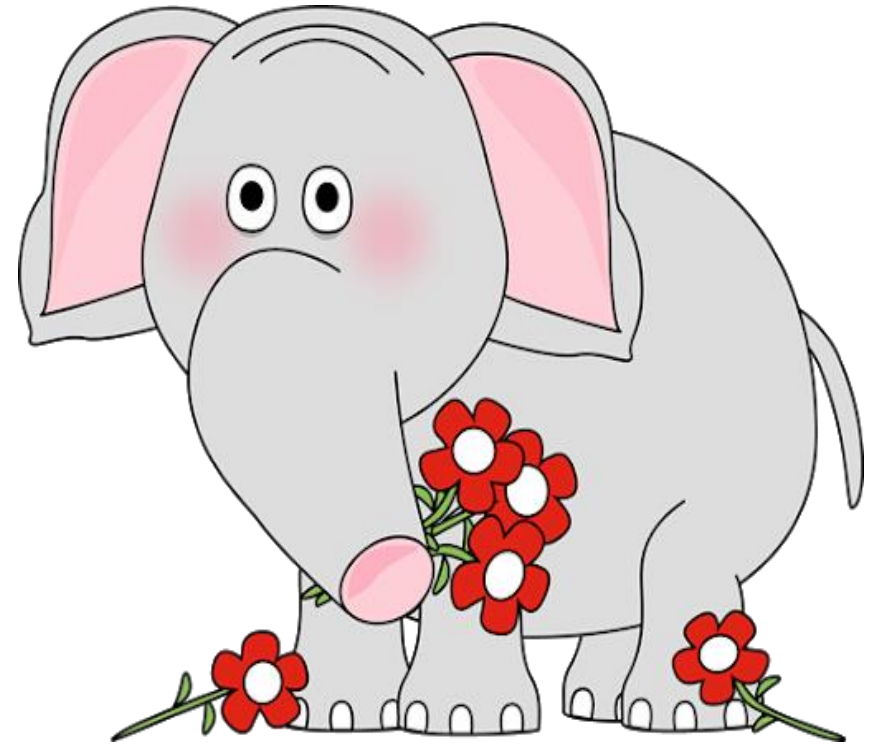


The challenge:

 Can you draw a picture of Dwynwen? How about decorating your picture with hearts? Can you copy or write a word/ short sentence to describe your picture e.e Dyma Dwynwen(This is Dwynwen) Roedd Dwynwen yn garedig(Dwynwen was kind)	 What about opening your own card shop? Get an adult to help you decide the price of each card. How many coins do you recognise? Can you sort the coins into different sets? How many 1p do you have? 2p/10p etc.	 Our heart is a very important organ! One way to get a healthy heart is to keep active. Can you think of different ways to move? How about going for a walk with the family/run around the garden/ jump up and down/hop on one leg? Can you notice a change in your heart rhythm? Is it beating faster?
 Can you name/ draw pictures/create a list of the most important people in your life. Discuss with an adult/sibling why they are important to you? Think of some kind things you could say to these people.	 With an adults help, can you write numbers up to 5/10/20/100 in an outline of hearts? How about playing a game with these hearts-arrange them in order/ ask an adult or an older sibling to hide 1 or 2 numbers-can you guess which numbers are missing? Think of numbers 1 more/1 less than a certain number.	 With an adult, why not attempt and create Saint Dwynwen's Fizzy Potion? How about recording the experiment and uploading to Hwb for your teachers to see?
 The word heart in Welsh is calon and calon begins with the letter c. How many words can you think of that begin with c? Go ahead and draw some of these objects. Can you practice forming the letter c? What about writing the words to match these pictures with support/ independently.	 Can you colour/paint an outline of a heart/hearts? How many colours did you use? Can you name these colours in Welsh? What about creating patterns on your hearts? Can you use straight and curved lines? How about creating some symmetrical patterns on your hearts? Remember to share these pictures with us.	 With an adult, go ahead and make some heart shaped biscuits or alternitavely you could decorate some cupcakes with red or pink icing. Enjoy these tasty treats with the rest of the family.
