- How many mini-beasts can you discover on your daily walk/in your garden?



Fortnightly Plan: Nature / Growth (Nursery / Reception) **Must do...**

- Recognising letters of the alphabet
- Practise forming letters of the alphabet
- Practise writing you name
- Regular reading – reading and listening to stories
- Practise singing songs and nursery rhymes

- Practise recognising numbers
- Practise forming numbers
- Recite numbers in the correct order – forwards and backwards
- Practise addition and subtraction by using practical activities

Should do.....



Use natural materials to practise forming / creating letters.



Keep a simple diary (picture / writing) about a nature walk.



Illustrate and organise pictures of yourself looking after the school's magical seed.



Create 2D shapes by using natural materials.



Go on a nature walk. Collect natural materials and order according to size – big / small OR from the smallest to the biggest.



Record the weather for the fortnight. How many sunny days? How many cold days? How many wet days?



Go on a sensory walk. Record what you see, hear, feel, smell and taste.



Build a mini-beast hotel by using natural materials.



Can you re-create animal/ mini-beast movements.
