Theme

Can you think of words beginning with the letter C? How about creating pictures/a list of these things?

Mr Urdd is the shape of a triangle. Can you find objects the same shape as Mr Urdd? How about creating triangles by using natural materials?

How about building a castle using materials of your choice e.g. LEGO, duplo, blocks, recycled boxes, natural materials (sticks etc). How about pretending to be a soldier in this castle?

Think of your favourite Welsh book. How about discussing the pictures and events from the story. Draw a picture of the cover.

What colour is Mr Urdd? Can you find red, white and green objects? Sort them into sets. Are there more red/white/green objects? How many objects are in each set?

Draw a picture of the Welsh flag/ Mr Urdd/ castles/ daffodils using coloured pencils, felt pens or paint to colour it or on Hwb.

Work with an adult to weigh and measure ingredients to create Welsh cakes/Cawl/Bara Brith. Draw a picture/create a list of the ingredients.

How about drawing large, medium and small pictures of daffodils, dragons, rugby balls, castles? Cut and organise these pictures.

Perform your favourite Welsh nursery rhyme. How about asking your family to join in? Share your clip with your teacher on Hwb or Twitter.
