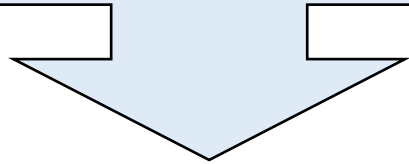


The Challenge:

Read the story 'Charlie the firefighter'/Sam Tân and discuss what happened the characters etc. Who was your favourite character? What was your favourite part of the book and why?



Choose one keyworker. Create a 2D/3D model of the vehicle they drive e.e. fire engine, tractor, lifeboat, ambulance, post van, bin lorry, supermarket delivery van etc.



Pick your favourite keyworker. Do you have a fancy dress costume? How about role playing this keyworker? What about including members of your family whilst role playing?



How about creating various badges for different roles for the members of your family? You could write the role or draw a picture on the badge e.g. nurse, police officer, doctor etc.



In an emergency you have to phone 999! Search for 9 objects around your house/in the garden. Can you think of numbers more/less than 9? Can you form the number 9? How about making number bonds to 9?



Sing the songs 'Pobl sy'n helpu'/'Cân Diolch' on the Cyw website. Record your performance! Do you remember the sign language for thank you?



Create a list of things that you could do to help around the house e.g. make your bed, wash the dishes, feed your pets!



How about opening your own shop e.g. a flowers shop/ supermarket? Use different coins up to 10p/20p to buy different items in your shop.



How about creating a lifeboat by using natural resources/recyclable materials. Can the lifeboat float on the water? Or does it sink? Draw pictures or take a photo of your creation.
