Fortnightly Plan: Summer (Yr. 5 & 6)

Rhaid gwneud... / Must do...

- Learn to spell common words - there is a list of the 200 most common words on the Website and you can use Spellblast on J2Blast to do this.
- Regular reading — remember to discuss what you have read, describe characters, explain events, sequence events, re-tell the story in your own words, use a dictionary/online dictionary to search for the meaning of unfamiliar vocabulary.

Adding and subtracting

Year 5 to use 4 digit numbers eg $3,498 + 2,538 =$ / $5,794 - 3,562$

Year 6 to use 4 digit numbers and decimals eg $4.6 + 2.3$ / $7.9 - 3.5$

Multiply and divide by 10,100 and 1000.

- Year 5 to use 3 digit numbers eg. 280,490,450,654
- Year 6 to use 3 digit numbers and decimals eg. 456, 732, 23.5, 12.9

Recognise and count money, pay for items in different ways.

- Tell the time to nearest minute
- How long does something take? How long is a tv programme? How long does it take to cook something? Estimate how long daily activities take.

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Keep active- what about joining Joe Wicks' live fitness sessions 9:00 – 9:30am on Youtube (with parental supervision)

Help - what about helping around the house? Make your bed, lay the table ready for food, help in the garden?

Talk- Have a chat with your parents about your day.

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★ Pretend you are on holiday in Burry Port. Why not write and send a postcard to a family member telling them what you have been up to? Remember to include short, sharp sentences with elements of the past, present and future in your writing. Template available.	★ Measure distance between two points on the beach. Time yourself moving from one point to another. Challenge yourself and others to move faster.	★ During lockdown, data shows that we've all been listening to more upbeat songs than usual. Create a playlist of songs that represent the summer. Are your choice of songs 'feel good' songs? Do they mention the summer/beach/sun etc? Can you create a hyperlink of each song from YouTube to Powerpoint? Also, make a written list of all the songs you have chosen.
★★ Burry Port is a lovely place to visit. Create a brochure persuading visitors to spend their holidays in the area. Remember to write in the first person, using good adjectives, and examples of alliteration. Use patterns of three: beautiful sandy beach etc. (Checklist of ideas attached).	★★ Organise your ideal holiday! You need to cost the trip thinking about the plane, hotel, food and activities. How many family members go? How much money do you need to save?	★★ Think of an image that means 'Summer' to you. Try to recreate your image at the beach using natural materials if needed. Upload images of your completed images as slides to Hwb or you can create a Pic Collage and upload to J2launch.
★★★ Write a story on the topic 'My Perfect Summer'. What made the summer perfect for you? Write in the past tense and include good descriptions. Can you write conversation between your characters using speech marks? Present your work in paragraphs on paper, on Word or on J2e5.	★★★ Look at the year 6 summer resource pack. Complete the worksheets.	★★★ Complete the step-by-step YouTube video by Oriolodl to draw a harbour pictures and words. Upload your pictures to J2launch.
