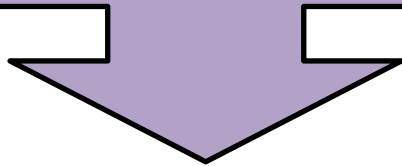


The challenge:

- Have you experienced something new during lockdown?



Fortnightly Plan: Time Capsule (Yr 5 & 6)

Rhaid gwneud... / Must do...

- Learn to spell common words - there is a list of the 200 most common words on the Website and you can use Spellblast on J2Blast to do this.
- Regular reading – remember to discuss what you have read, describe characters, explain events, sequence events, re-tell the story in your own words, use a dictionary/online dictionary to search for the meaning of unfamiliar vocabulary.

- **Practice times tables** (Don't forget you can also use TT Rockstars and J2Blast to practice tables)

Adding and subtracting

Year 5 to use 4 digit numbers eg
ee $3,498 + 2,538 =$ / $5,794 - 3,562$

Year 6 to use 4 digit numbers and decimals ee $4.6 + 2.3$ / $7.9 - 3.5$

Multiply and divide by 10,100 and 1000.

- Year 5 to use 3 digit numbers eg. 280,490,450,654
- Year 6 to use 3 digit numbers and decimals eg. 456, 732, 23.5, 12.9

Recognise and count money, pay for items in different ways.

- Tell the time to nearest

★ Complete the 'Time Capsule' worksheet. Don't panic if you can't print the sheet. Present your work on Word or J2e5.	★ Create a timeline of personal events. Start from your date of birth to the present day. You can use pictures and words. Remember to enter the date and that the time line is in chronological order.	★ Create a time capsule. Use a box or a bottle. This capsule can be to remember this Covid time (or Year 6, your time at Ysgol Parc y Tywyn) Collect pictures, newspapers, 'screenshots' clothes etc. Decorate your capsule.
★ Write a letter to your next teacher telling them what you think they should know about your time at Parc y Tywyn. Talk about your experiences, your friends, your work in class or anything else you think they should know. Remember to make it sound interesting so that they can look forward to meeting you! ★ Writing an autobiography. Present your work in paragraphs, each one with different information, eg. 1. Name, age, etc., 2. Your family, 3. Your hobbies, 4. Any other information. ★ Remember to use descriptions in your work and talk about your feelings. ('All About Me' template, 'Features of an Autobiography' for guidance).	★ Look at the Timetable cards. Answer the questions.	★★ Look at the Covid-19 art works. Try and create your own picture or collage to represent this time (or Year 6, yours could represent your time and memories at Ysgol Parc y Tywyn.) It can

		include important symbols of this time- rainbows, emotions, family, your favourite things. You can use any medium you like - pencil, paint, collage.
