- Learn to spell common words - there is a list of the 200 most common words on the Website and you can use Spellblast on J2Blast to do this. - Regular reading – remember to discuss what you have read, describe characters, explain events, sequence events, re-tell the story in your own words, use a dictionary/online dictionary to search for the meaning of unfamiliar vocabulary.	Practice times tables (Don't forget you can also use TT Rockstars and J2Blast to practice tables) Year 5 & 6: Times tables 2 - 12 Adding and subtracting Year 5 to use 4 digit numbers eg $3,498 + 2,538 =$ / $5,794 - 3,562$ Year 6 to use 4 digit numbers and decimals eg $4.6 + 2.3$ / $7.9 - 3.5$ Multiply and divide by 10, 100 and 1000. Year 5 to use 3 digit numbers eg. 280,490,450,654 Year 6 to use 3 digit numbers and decimals eg. 456, 732, 23.5, 12.2 Year 5 and 6 Procedural Mats (Matiau Gweithdrefnol) - Recognise and count money, pay for items in different ways. - Tell the time to nearest minute - How long does something take? How long is a tv programme? How long does it take to cook something? Estimate how long daily activities take.	<u>Keep active</u>- what about joining Joe Wicks' live fitness sessions 9:00 – 9:30am on Youtube (with parental supervision) <u>Help</u> - what about helping around the house? Make your bed, lay the table ready for food, help in the garden? <u>Talk</u>- Have a chat with your parents about your day.

★	Collect facts about each of the Emergency Services. Create an information poster for each service on J2e5 o Word.	★	You need to create your own math word problems. Remember to create an emergency situation to add, subtract, multiply and divide. E.g. 6 fire engines arrive at the park. There are 4 firemen in each. How many firemen are there in total? Make the problem as simple or as difficult as you like but remember, you must be able to solve the problem.	★	Use the knots page to learn how to tie at least 5 different knots. Learn where and when they would be useful. If possible, take a picture of your knots and upload them onto your Hwb account. You can use string, wool, rope – anyway material you can tie. Why have a race to tie the best knots?
★★	Write a set of instructions on how to play any team game. Remember to include: Title, Resources, Rules and Imperative verbs for each point. Can you include a top tip to finish?	★★	NHS employees get 10% off goods in a shop. What's the price after getting 10% off? 1. Mobile phone £150 = --- 2. Sunglasses £60 - - - 3. Sun Hat - £ 20 = ----- 4. TV - £ 550 = ---- - 5. Xbox - £ 250 = ----- 6. Laptop - £ 190 = --- - 7. Freezer - £ 170 = ----- 8. Bike - £ 410 = -- - 9. Scooter - £ 85 = ----- 10. Air Pods - £ 155 = Remember to divide by 10 and then subtract from the original price.	★★	What is First Aid? Look at the sheet "What you need to know" to see how you could help in different emergency situations or visit this website https://lifeliveit.redcross.org.uk/What-is-first-aid Why not practice putting bandages on a family member?! See the "Bandages" sheet. Use a head scarf, a scarf or a strip of material if you have no bandages.
★★★	Write a script on the theme 'Emergency 999'. Think about your characters, setting, a new line for each new speaker. Present your work on J2e5. Can you include sound?	★★★	Key workers get money off different goods. How much are the goods with the discount? 25% off a mountain bike costing £420. 75% off a Samsung TV costing £ 1200. On J2e5 create similar questions yourself. E.g. Can you find the cost after getting a certain discount? 50% of £ 100, 25% of £ 200, 75% of £ 200. Remember that $50\% = \frac{1}{2}$ (half) $25\% = \frac{1}{4}$ (quarter) $75\% = \frac{3}{4}$ (three quarters) $10\% = \frac{1}{10}$ (one tenth)	★★★	What should you do in a first aid emergency? See the "What to do in a First Aid emergency" sheet. Put the stages in order and then create an information poster or video to explain to others. You can also use information from the task above.
