Fortnightly Plan: Wales (Yr 5 & 6)

Rhaid gwneud... / Must do...

- Learn to spell common words - there is a list of the 200 most common words on the Website and you can use Spellblast on J2Blast to do this.
- Regular reading – remember to discuss what you have read, describe characters, explain events, sequence events, re-tell the story in your own words, use a dictionary/online dictionary to search for the meaning of unfamiliar vocabulary.

- Practice times tables (Don't forget you can also use TT Rockstars and J2Blast to practice tables)

Year 5 & 6: Times tables 2 - 12

- Adding and subtracting

Year 5 to use 4 digit numbers eg $3,498 + 2,538 =$ / $5,794 - 3,562$

Year 6 to use 4 digit numbers and decimals eg $4.6 + 2.3$ / $7.9 - 3.5$

- Multiply and divide by 10,100 and 1000.

Year 5 to use 3 digit numbers eg. 280,490,450,654

Year 6 to use 3 digit numbers and decimals eg. 456,732, 23.5, 12.2

Year 5 and 6 Procedural Mats (Matiau Gweithdrefnol)

- Recognise and count money, pay for items in different ways.
- Tell the time to nearest minute
- How long does something take? How long is a tv programme? How long does it take to cook something? Estimate how long daily activities take.

Keep active- what about joining Joe Wicks' live fitness sessions 9:00 – 9:30am on Youtube (with parental supervision)

Help - what about helping around the house? Make your bed, lay the table ready for food, help in the garden?

Use google maps or AA Routefinder to find out how far away they are. Put them in order from the nearest to the furthest away. Put the information in a table on Spreadsheet in J2Office.	★ <u>Peace Schools Task 1:</u> Research Peace signs and either draw or create a collage of the ones you have found. Then choose one symbol. Take a picture with a camera and upload to any 'emoji mosaic' app. Your image will be created in emojis. Tweet your image to @parcytywyn with the hashtags #pyt #heddwch
★★ Write a poem of your choice about Wales. Maybe create shape poems, rhyming poems or a two-line poem. Present your work on Word with images. (Remember text wrap to move your image).	★★ Make a list of Welsh rivers. Discover the length of Welsh rivers. Sort them from longest to shortest. Which is the longest? The shortest? What is the difference between the longest and shortest river? Put the information in a table on Spreadsheet in J2Office.	★★ <u>Peace Schools Task 2:</u> Choose one peace symbol. Paint your symbol onto a stone and write 'Cymru Dros Heddwch' on the other side. Tweet your work to @parcytywyn with the hashtags #pyt #heddwch
★★★ Wales has quite an unique history. Why not write a story about a Welsh icon or trwy to re-write an old Welsh legend? Remember good adjectives, similes and idioms in your work.	★★★ Make a list of the mountains of Wales. Find the height of the mountains. Sort them from smallest to highest. Which is the highest? Which is the smallest? What's the difference between them? How far are they from your home? Put the information in a table on Spreadsheet in J2Office.	★★★ Choose a Welsh song from the list (attached sheet). Film yourself singing/dancing/singing and dancing to the song. Upload your video track to J2Launch.
