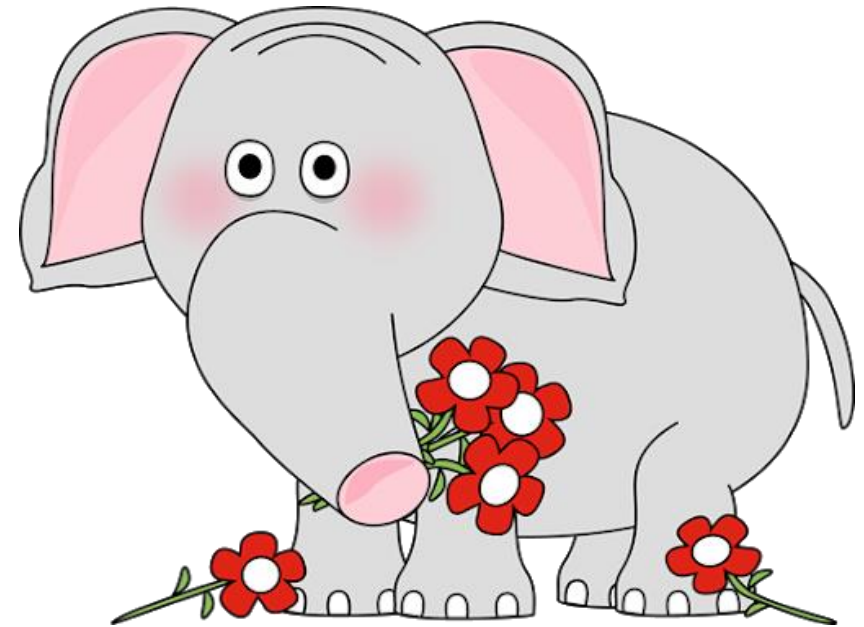


The Challenge:

What about playing a game with these cards e.g. ordering them, hiding them, what about hiding a number and guessing which one is missing? etc



Design and create a Santes Dwywnwen's Day card or what about painting / colouring a red heart and decorating it.
Remember to share your work with us.



Write a set of instructions on how to bake heart shaped biscuits.
Remember to list what you will need to do by using imperative verbs.



Complete the Santes Dwywnwen's symmetry worksheet (Resource 3)
CHALLENGE: Can you design your own symmetry pattern?



With an adult, why not attempt and create Saint Dwywnwen's Fizzy Potion?
Follow the instructions (Resource 4)
How about recording the experiment and uploading to Hwb for your teachers to see?



Use the picture cards given (Resource 1).
Organise the pictures and write sentences that co-inside with each picture.
*CHALLENGE - How about re-writing the whole story in your own words?



With an adult, go ahead and bake heart shaped biscuits. Ensure that you note all the ingredients that you will need as well as the correct measurements e.g. how many grams (g), how many millilitres (ml) etc.
Go ahead and decorate your biscuits and enjoy them with your family.



It is very important to keep our hearts healthy. One way of doing this is to make sure we have plenty of physical exercise. Think of different ways of moving - how about going for a walk with your family or run / hop / jump around the garden. Can you notice the changes to your heartbeat? Is it beating faster? Can you count how many beats there are in a minute? What about recording the heartbeat of the members of your family?
