Why not invite your teacher for a tea party? Complete the simple invitation template (Resource 1) CHALLENGE: Go ahead and create you own party invitation. Remember to include: name, time, date, location, costume, activites, food and any relevant information.	Look at Resource 3 - Repeating pattern. Go ahead and re-create this pattern by using different materials and techniques (colouring, painting, using chalk, crayons etc) CHALLENGE: How about creating your own repeating pattern? Think of different animals in order to design your own bespoke pattern.	Go ahead and create a label for a can of tiger food. Think of an interesting name and ensure that it is eye-catching. Remember to share your work with us.
Use the picture cards provided (Resource 2) Organise the cards correctly and include a simple sentence that coincides with each picture. CHALLENGE: How about re-writing the whole story using your own words.	Research into animals that are carnivores and herbivoes. Sort these animals by using different sorting techniques e.g. table, Venn diagram, Carroll diagram.	Create a tea party menu for your teacher. Note what food you will prepare. CHALLENGE: Note the price of each item and record your total spend.
Use the picture cards given (Resource 2). Go ahead and recite the story in your own words. How about recording yourself reciting the story and upload to HWB for your teacher to hear?	Every animal is different, with various features and different measurements. Go ahead and measure different parts of your body e.e. hand span, length of arm, length of foot, height, circumference of your head etc. Ensure that you note your measurements in centimetres. CHALLENGE: What about measuring and comparing different members of your family?	Go ahead and create a tiger of your choice e.g. 3D model, picture, Lego model etc. Hide your tiger, cut and use the paw prints provided (Resource 4) to create a tiger trail for members for your family in your garden/ house. CHALLENGE: What about creating a detailed map to complete your trail?
