If you would like your child to compete in any art and Craft competitions, we ask that you work on these at home and bring their entries to school by Tuesday 14th April, 2026.

There are 4 categories for competing – Year 2 and below, Years 3 & 4 and Years 5 & 6 individual.

Competitions marked with ** are for groups of children Year 6 and under.

Below is a list of the Arts and Crafts competitions.

This year the theme for all entries is **DREAMS**.

T Shirt Design

Design a T-Shirt (front and back) to celebrate your habitat.

Cartoon Character

Devise and create your own cartoon character. Draw and write about the character with a 200 word limit.

2D Drawing

Create a picture using one or a combination of these media: Pencil, Ink, Crayon, Pastel or Paint to measure no more than 760mm x 560mm

Creative 2D **

Submit any 2D work using one or a combination of the following media: Mosaic, Collage, Tile, Wood, Plastic or Metal to measure no more than 760mm x 560mm

Computer Graphics

Original computer-generated work measuring no more than A4.

Modified Photograph

Modify your own photograph to create a new digital image. A scanner and any software can be used to edit and create one finished piece of work measuring approximately A4 (e.g 10"x8" neu 12"x10"). The original photograph must accompany the work.

Photography: Black and White Photo

One black and white or monochrome photograph to measure no more than A4. All items should be mounted on paper or card. All photographs should be presented on standard photograph paper. Photocopies and editing are not permitted.

Photography: Colour Photo

One colour photograph to measure no more than A4. All items should be mounted on paper or card. All photographs should be presented on standard photograph paper. Photocopies and editing are not permitted.

Photography: A Series of Black and White Photos

A series of 4 black and white or monochrome photographs. Each photo to measure no more than A5. All items should be mounted on paper or card. All photographs should be presented on standard photograph paper. Photocopies and editing are not permitted.

Photography: A Series of Colour Photos

A series of 4 colour photographs. Each photo to measure no more than A5. All items should be mounted on paper or card. All photographs should be presented on standard photograph paper. Photocopies and editing are not permitted.

Print **

Print on any material using one or a combination of media and techniques including: Lining, Wood, Plastic, Paper, Fabric or Metal to measure no more than 760mm x 560mm

Decorating on Fabric

Decorate on 2D or 3D fabric using any technique or combination of techniques such as: Painting, Print, Stitching, Tie and Flow, Batic, Block Printing, Embroidery (manual or machined) or Using a Computer, to measure no more than 750mm x 750mm x 750mm.

Creating fabric or an item made of fabric

Create 2D or 3D work that uses materials and techniques such as: Felting, Hand or machine knitting, Hand or machine sewing, Crocheting or weaving, to measure no more than 750mm x 750mm x 750mm

Fashion **

Create a new item of clothing to wear, using any materials

Puppets **

Up to 3 puppets of any kind such as: finger, hand or string. A puppet on a string should be presented in a decorative bespoke frame for hanging/display only. No decorations or accessories to the frame will be judged as part of the work. The dimension of the frame to hold the puppets should not exceed 750mm x 750mm x 750mm.

3D Work **

Present 3D work in any medium or combination of media. Work in this category would be visual from all directions (except the bottom if standing on the ground) and maintain itself, measuring no more than 750mm x 750mm x 750mm and weighing less than 12kg.

Upcycling **

Upcycle any object using recycled materials that are fit for purpose. Photograph(s) of the original object or raw materials must be included as evidence of the action taken. Finished work to measure no more than 750mm x 750mm x 750mm

Ceramics **

The clay must have had at least one biscuit firing in a kiln but it is permitted to use air dried clay. The work should fit into a 400mm x 400mm x 400mm frame or box

Jewellery **

Original jewellery in any medium or combination of media.

Design and Technology **

Produce any Design and Technology work to measure no more than 750mm x 750mm x 750mm and weigh less than 12kg. Include a written presentation and provide evidence explaining the stages of development and submission.

Additional information:

The size of each item:

a) 2D Work: No more than 760mm x 560mm

b) 3D Work: No more than 750mm x 750mm x 750mm

c) Ceramics/pottery work: No more than 400mm x 400mm x 400mm

3D Definition - An object that's visible from each direction and is self-supportive.

Weight - 3D Work should not weigh more than 12kg

Mounting - In order to protect the work, mounting on black paper or card is permitted. There are specific guidelines for the photography section. Using a 'window mount' or a frame for 2D work is not permitted, apart from where a frame is necessary for the work's structure. The winning entries will be professionally mounted for the exhibition.
