Changes to the School Day – Parent Consultation Outcome

Dear Parent/Carer,

Following the letter sent to parents on 7.05.25 a questionnaire was shared to gather your views on the proposed changes to the school day. In addition, parents were offered the opportunity to discuss or oppose the proposal during a meeting held on 21.05.25. Thank you to all those parents and carers who shared views with us, either through the questionnaire or by attending the consultation meetings. After careful consideration of all feedback received, the Governing Body has now met and agreed to proceed with the proposal.

From **1st of September 2025** the new school day will be as follows:

Start time: 08:50

Finish time: 14:50 - Nursery to Year 2
15:05 - Year 3 - 6

Breakfast Club will start at **08:00**, and the doors will close promptly at **08:15**.

Drop-off and Collection Times

- The main school gate will open for **drop-off** at **08:40** and close promptly at **08:50**.
- The main school gate will open for **collection** for Nursery to Year 2 at **14:45** and close promptly at **15:00**.
- Pupils from Year 3 – 6 will be collected from an allocated door at the front of the school (Main entrance, Studio or Main Hall).
- More details will be shared in our Parent Welcome Meeting after half term.

****Collection at the end of the day***- If you have children who finish at different times, you can collect all siblings together at 15.05. You will not need to pick each child up separately. This will help you avoid waiting up to 15 minutes between different collection times.

Further information on after school activities will be provided ahead of the start of the next school year.

We would like to thank all parents, carers, and members of our school community who took the time to share their views and engage in the consultation process. Your input is valued and plays an important part in helping us move forward in the best interests of our pupils' educational outcomes, wellbeing and safety, as well as the interests of the wider school community.

We look forward to implementing the new times in September and to working closely with the school community to further support our pupils.
