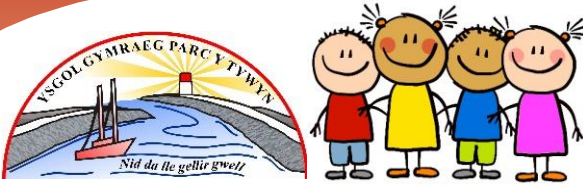

Attendance and Punctuality



Mae presenoldeb rheolaidd yn allweddol os yw plentyn am fanteisio i'r eithaf ar eu cyfnod yn yr ysgol. Mae'r ysgol yn pwysleisio bod presenoldeb rheolaidd yn hollbwysig er mwyn sicrhau datblygiad addysgol a chymdeithasol y plentyn. **Mae absenoldebau cyson yn golygu nad oes dilyniant yn y broses ddysgu ac felly yn arwain at dangyflawni.**

Regular attendance and punctuality are important if children are to take part fully in the life of the school and to take advantage of the learning opportunities offered by the school. We recognise that attending school regularly and punctually is vital to the educational process and encourages a good pattern of work. **Children only get one chance at school, and your child's chances of a successful future may be affected by not attending school regularly.**

Prydlondeb - Mae'r diwrnod ysgol yn dechrau am **9.00 yb / 1:00 yh** - unrhyw un sydd yn cyrraedd ar ol hyn fe fyddant yn derbyn marc hwyr a bydd angen cofrestru eich plentyn ar yr ipad yn y swyddfa.

Gofynnir i rieni gasglu ei plentyn yn brydlon ar ddiwedd y sesiwn am **11.20yb** i'r Meithrin Bore ac am **3:20yp** i'r Meithrin Prynhawn a'r Meithrin Llawn. Ni fydd plant yn cael gadael yn gynnar oni bai bod apwyntiad doctor ayyb ganddynt.

Plentyn yn Sâl - Disgwylir i rieni roi eglurhad **cyn 9.15yb** ar y **diwrnod cyntaf** y bydd eich plentyn yn absennol. Oni fyddwn yn derbyn galwad ffôn neu gweld y rhiant yna fe nodir fod eich plentyn yn absennol heb ganiatâd.

The door will open for the children at **8.50am** for the morning Nursery and at **1:00pm** for the afternoon Nursery and a member of the Nursery staff will greet the children at the start of the session. The part time children will come into school through the Studio door entrance. Morning nursery will leave through the Studio door and the afternoon nursery will leave through the class door.

Punctuality - **The school day begins at 9.00am / 1:00pm** - any child arriving after this will receive a late mark and you will need to sign your child in on the ipad at the office.

All parents are expected to collect their child on time at the end of the session at 11.20am for the Morning Nursery and at 3:20pm for the afternoon Nursery and full time Nursery. No children will be allowed to leave early except in cases where the child has a doctors appointment for example.

Absence due to illness - It is imperative that parents provide an explanation on the first day your child is absent. You are requested to notify the school before **9.15am on the first day your child is ill**. Unless we receive a telephone call or a visit from the parent, then your child's absence will be registered as unauthorised.

Should I keep my child off school?

Yes

	Until...
Chickenpox	at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all blisters have crusted over
Diarrhoea and Vomiting	48 hours after their last episode
Cold and Flu-like illness (including COVID-19)	they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to attend. Follow the national guidance if they've tested positive for COVID-19
Impetigo	their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics
Measles	4 days after the rash first appeared
Mumps	5 days after the swelling started
Scabies	they've had their first treatment
Scarlet Fever	24 hours after they started taking antibiotics

Restorative Practice

As a school we are focused on building Positive Relationships and we have four school rules which we expect all pupils to follow.

RESPECT - *for everyone by listening to other opinions and learning to value each other.*

RESPONSIBILITY - *taking responsibility for your own actions and developing the skills within our school community so that its individual members have the necessary skills to identify solutions that repair harm and ensure behaviours are not repeated.*

WELSHNESS –*promoting the Welsh language and enjoying socialising through the Welsh language.*

PERCEVERANCE - recognize that we make mistakes, sometimes find it difficult to complete tasks. Persist, find solutions/ways to move forward.

Home-school Agreement

In September we will share a home-school agreement. This agreement is designed to help your child develop in supportive, happy surroundings, both at school and at home so that he/she can make the most of the opportunities available during his/her time at school. It is hoped that every pupil from Year Three onwards will sign the agreement after it has been explained to them by their parents. Parents of all children are expected to sign the document.

Annogwn ein disgyblion i wisgo gwisg swyddogol yr ysgol. Yn ogystal, mae esgidiau a gwisg addas yn angenrheidiol ar gyfer gwersi Addysg Gorfforol. Nid yw jîns neu ddillad a chanddynt sloganau neu logos masnachol arnynt yn dderbyniol fel gwisg ysgol. Fe fydd sawl cyfle yn ystod y flwyddyn i wisgo'n hamddenol ar ddiwrnodau pwrpasol (e.e. "Plant mewn Angen").

Ni ddylai plant wisgo unrhyw emwaith i'r ysgol – mae hyn yn cynnwys clustdlysau cylchyn, mwclis a breichledau. Mae ar gyfer lechyd a Diogelwch y plant. Stydiau yw'r unig eitem dderbyniol.

Erfyniwn arnoch i osod enw eich plentyn yn glir ar ei dd/dillad. Heb enw, ni fydd modd i ni ddod o hyd i ddillad coll.

Pupils are encouraged to wear the school's official uniform. Also, appropriate clothes and footwear are essential for Physical Education lessons. Denim jeans and clothes bearing commercial slogans and logos are not acceptable as school uniform. There are however several opportunities during the year to "dress down" on designated days (For example, "Children in Need").

Children should not wear any jewellery to school – this includes hooped earrings, necklaces and bracelets. It is for the Health and Safety of the children. Studs are the only acceptable item.

We urge you to write your child's name clearly on his/her clothes. Without a name, we will not be able to identify the owners of any lost property.

- Play
- Attention
- Receptivness
- Expressivness
- Social Communication
- Speech

Children work in small groups focusing on one element at a time. The element assessed as needing the most attention.

We ask all parents to complete a new Health Certificate annually. This form includes all contact details and permissions needed. We have now made this form electronic if you find it easier to complete and return online.

Please remember to contact the office if any details change though out the year eg. new phone numbers. It is extremely important that we can contact you during the day in case of emergency.

Please ensure that you complete the FRONT and BACK of the form.

We ask that you provide a password for your child in case anyone we are unfamiliar with needs to collect your child at any time.

Only Years 5&6 can walk to cars or home following completion of the permissions form. **Older siblings are not permitted to collect their brothers or sisters.**

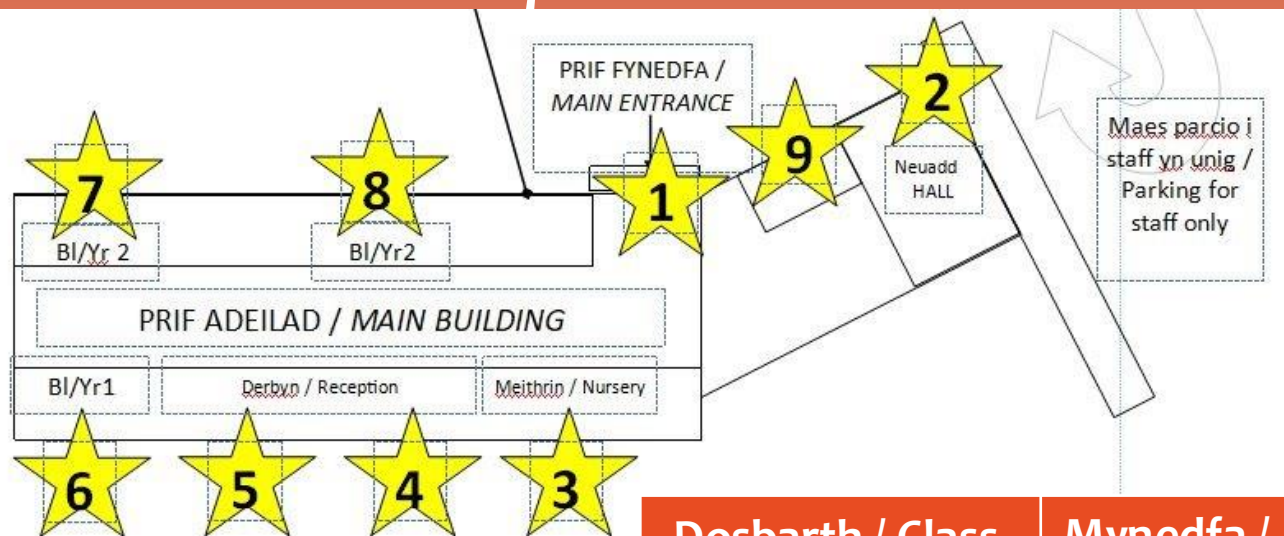
