Regular attendance and punctuality are important if children are to take part fully in the life of the school and to take advantage of the learning opportunities offered by the school. We recognise that attending school regularly and punctually is vital to the educational process and encourages a good pattern of work. **Children only get one chance at school, and your child's chances of a successful future may be affected by not attending school regularly.**

Reception, Years 1 and 2 - The gates will open at 8:50am.

The school is not responsible for pupils that arrive at school before 8.50am as there is no adult supervision by the school gate.

Punctuality - The school day begins at 9.00am - any child arriving after this will receive a late mark.

All parents are expected to collect their child on time at the end of the session at 3:20pm. No children will be allowed to leave early except in cases where the child has a doctors appointment for example.

Absence due to illness - It is imperative that parents provide an explanation on the first day your child is absent. You are requested to notify the school before 9.15am on the first day your child is ill. Unless we receive a telephone call or a visit from the parent, then your child's absence will be registered as unauthorised.

Holiday request - If you are intending on going on holidays, please complete a "leave of absence" form and return to the school office at least ten school days before your intended holiday. If your child's attendance is lower than 92% the holiday will not be authorised.

Restorative Practice

As a school we are focused on building Positive Relationships and we have four school rules which we expect all pupils to follow.

RESPECT - *for everyone by listening to other opinions and learning to value each other.*

RESPONSIBILITY - *taking responsibility for your own actions and developing the skills within our school community so that its individual members have the necessary skills to identify solutions that repair harm and ensure behaviours are not repeated.*

CYMREICTOD – *promoting the Welsh language and enjoying socialising through the Welsh language.*

PERCEVERANCE - *recognize that we make mistakes, sometimes find it difficult to complete tasks. Persist, find solutions/ways to move forward.*

Home-school Agreement

In September we will share a home-school agreement. This agreement is designed to help your child develop in supportive, happy surroundings, both at school and at home so that he/she can make the most of the opportunities available during his/her time at school. It is hoped that every pupil from Year Three onwards will sign the agreement after it has been explained to them by their parents. Parents of all children are expected to sign the document.

Children should not wear any jewellery to school – this includes hooped earrings, necklaces and bracelets. Studs are the only acceptable item. They should wear fully closed in shoes. It is for the Health and Safety of the children.

We urge you to write your child's name clearly on his/her clothes. Unless this is done, we will not be able to identify the owners of any lost property.

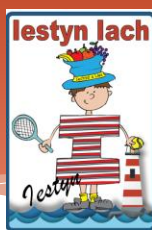
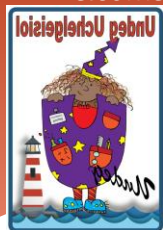

Each year group's home learning challenge sheet has a space for parent/carer's feedback and for children's feedback. These sheets should be returned to school with the completed home learning challenges the week before half term.

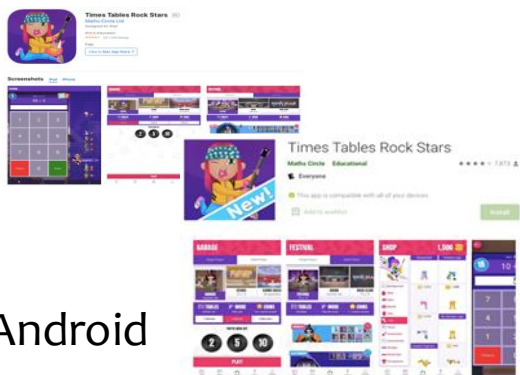

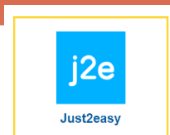

Tric a Chlic is a synthetic phonics program. The program is built from 3 elements:

- hearing and recognizing sounds,

- segmenting (cut) sounds to spell.

The children will also:

- ❖ Learn and recognize specific sounds
- ❖ Learn how to form letters correctly
- ❖ Blend sounds together along with segmentation

The children are assessed termly, and appropriate work and activities are prepared as a result of the assessments to ensure that the children receive the correct intervention.

J2 Blast also offers a spelling game to aid with learning spellings.

Please ensure that you complete the FRONT and BACK of the form.

We ask that you provide a password for your child in case anyone we are unfamiliar with needs to collect your child at any time.

Only Years 5&6 can walk to cars or home following completion of the permissions form. **Older siblings are not permitted to collect their brothers or sisters.**

It is not expected of any member of staff to arrange or to administer any medicines for children in school. However, circumstances may arise where children are well enough to attend school having been prescribed medicine by their GP.

In cases such as this, parents must contact the school and complete a consent form enabling members of staff to administer prescribed medicines. Where possible, parents should ask their GP to prescribe medicine for their child that does not require the administration of any dosage during the school day. School staff cannot administer medicines that have not been prescribed by a doctor. We kindly ask for two lots of medication to be kept in school.

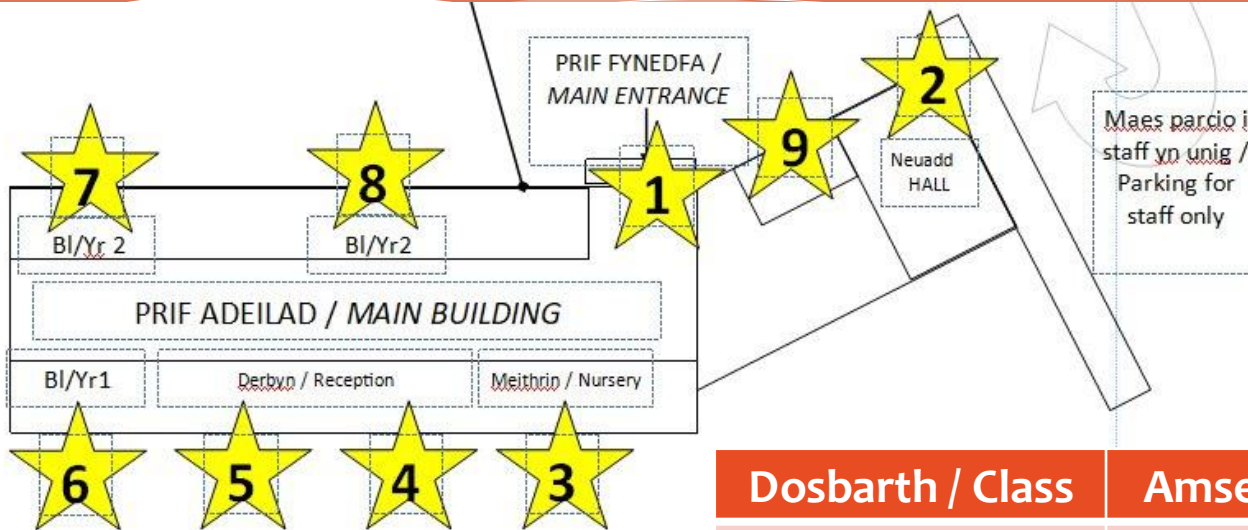
