Dear Parent/Guardian,

When reading the feedback and the progress reports it is IMPORTANT to remember that both are snapshots of your child's understanding in school at the time they were taken. Both provide a source of information on your child's development, however, the best, and most reliable source of information is always the information you receive through reading your child's school report. Your child's teacher has worked with him/her for a whole year and has a very good understanding of progress and achievements and these are celebrated in the report.

PROGRESS REPORT: your child's graph may show a general improvement, or may show a decline, this is when you need to keep in mind:

- Your child's emotional response to the test
- It's an unfamiliar experience way of working
- It was an electronic test where the questions would vary in difficulty according to your child's previous answers. Therefore, if your child had guessed the previous answer and was correct the level of difficulty would increase significantly, influencing the overall result

At Parc y Tywyn we use a holistic approach to teaching where lessons are planned to meet individual needs and interests, where children are encouraged to be involved in their learning. These tests are set in way where no discussion is allowed, and they are done in a way where teachers cannot offer the support and guidance that our children are familiar with.
