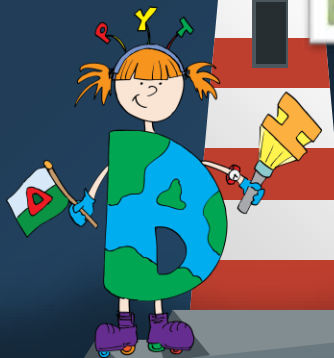


Meithrin / Derbyn

Ein thema y tymor hwn yw *"Byw yn y Baw"*. Mae'r plant wedi mwynhau archwilio byd rhyfeddol y baw a'r pryfed bach yn fawr iawn. Rydym wedi bod yn chwilio am bryfed bach yn yr awyr agored, yn dysgu am eu cynefinoedd ac yn trafod pam mae gwahanol amgylcheddau yn le da iddynt fyw. Mae'r plant wedi didoli pryfed bach yn ôl meini prawf gwahanol megis adenydd/dim adenydd, ymchwilio i flodau a bywyd gwyllt, plannu blodau ac olrhain twf planhigion dros amser. Rydym hefyd wedi datblygu ein sgiliau creadigol a gwaith tîm trwy greu pryfed bach allan o glai ac adeiladu cuddfannau. Mae'r plant wedi dangos llawer o frwdfrydedd wrth ddysgu sut i ofalu am flodau, planhigion a'r bywyd gwyllt o'n cwrdd.



This half term, our Nursery and Reception class theme has been *"Living in the Mud"*. The children have thoroughly enjoyed exploring the wonderful world of mud and minibeasts. We have been searching for minibeasts outdoors, learning about their habitats and discussing why different environments are the best places for them to live. The children have sorted minibeasts using different criteria such as wings/no wings, investigated flowers and wildlife, planted flowers and tracked plant growth over time. We have also developed our creative and teamwork skills through clay minibeast modelling and den building activities. The children have shown great enthusiasm while learning how to care for flowers, plants and the wildlife around us.



Derbyn/Blwyddyn 1

Blwyddyn 1

Mae Blwyddyn 1 wedi cael dechrau gwych i'r hanner tymor gyda'n thema newydd, *Byw yn y Baw*. Buom ar helpa chwilod ac yn archwilio eu cynefinoedd, cyn creu byrbrydau chwilod blasus allan o ffrwythau. Edrychwn ymlaen yn awr at ddysgu am blanhigion y tymor nesaf.



Year 1 have had an exciting start to the half term with our new theme, *Byw yn y Baw*! The children have loved taking part in lots of bug-themed activities and have shown incredible enthusiasm throughout. One of the highlights was watching our caterpillars transform into beautiful butterflies while keeping a special diary to record each stage of their journey. There was great excitement in the classroom when the butterflies finally emerged from their cocoons! We have also enjoyed observing the worms in our wormery and discovering how they travel through the compost. Our bug hunts helped us explore the fascinating habitats where minibeasts live, and we even created delicious insect-themed treats using fruit. We are very excited to begin learning all about plants next half term!

Blwyddyn 2

Mae wedi bod yn hanner tymor prysur a chyffrous arall ym Mlwyddyn 2! Mae ein dysgu wedi canolbwyntio ar bopeth sy'n ymwneud â bwystfilod bach. Mae'r plant wedi mwynhau archwilio eu hamgylchedd lleol, mynd ar helfeydd bwystfilod bach a darganfod ble mae'r creaduriaid hyn yn byw. Rydym hefyd wedi bod yn dysgu am strwythurau eu cyrff a sut maen nhw wedi addasu i'w cynefinoedd.

Uchafbwynt y tymor oedd adeiladu ein mwydodfa ein hunain. Mae'r plant yn gyffrous iawn i weld sut mae'r mwydod yn ymddwyn a'r hyn maen nhw'n ei wneud o dan y pridd!

Rydym hefyd wedi cymryd gofal mawr wrth ofalu am y planhigion yn ein man dysgu awyr agored, gan eu helpu i dyfu a ffynnu. Mwy o waith ar hyn ar ôl hanner tymor.

I orffen yr hanner tymor ar ei orau, fe wnaethon ni fwynhau taith wych i'r Gerddi Botaneg Cenedlaethol, a ddaeth â'n dysgu yn fyw a rhoi cyfle gwyb i'r plant archwilio natur ymhellach.



It has been another busy and exciting half term in Year 2! Our learning has focused on all things minibeasts. The children have enjoyed exploring their local environment, going on minibeast hunts and discovering where these creatures live. We have also been learning about their body structures and how they are adapted to their habitats.

A highlight of the term was building our very own wormery. The children are very excited to observe how the worms behave and what they get up to beneath the soil!

We have also taken great care in looking after the plants in our outdoor learning area, helping them to grow and thrive. More work on this after half term.

To end the half term on a high, we enjoyed a fantastic trip to the National Botanical Gardens, which brought our learning to life and gave the children a wonderful opportunity to explore nature further.

Blwyddyn 3

Aeth plant Blwyddyn 3 ar ymweliad addysgol i Benclacwydd ac fe wnaethon nhw ei fwynhau'n fawr iawn. Roedd y daith yn cysylltu'n berffaith â'n thema **Plymio'r Pwll**, ac roedd y plant wrth eu boddau'n chwilio am bryfed ac infertebratau bach, gan eu didoli yn ôl a oedd ganddynt goesau ai peidio. Yna cafodd y plant gyfle i blymio'r pwll, gan ddefnyddio rhwydi i ddarganfod beth oedd yn byw yn y dŵr, cyn adnabod yr anifeiliaid a ddarganfyddwyd. Ar ben hynny, cawsant lawer o hwyl yn cerdded o gwmpas y gwlyptiroedd ac yn chwarae yn y parc.



Year 3 children went on an educational visit to Penclacwydd and thoroughly enjoyed their experience. The trip linked perfectly to our theme, 'Plymio'r Pwll', and the children had great fun searching for bugs and insects, sorting them into groups depending on whether they had legs or no legs. They then had the chance to do pond dipping, using nets to discover what lived in the pond before identifying the animals they found. They also had lots of fun walking around the wetlands and playing in the park.

Blwyddyn 3 Mrs Evans

Yn dilyn gwaith thema ar *Blymio'r Pwll*, aeth Blwyddyn 3 ar daith diddorol i Wlyptir Penclacwydd. Cawsom gyfleoedd i gymryd rhan mewn gweithgareddau wrth arsylwi ar fywyd gwylt. Gwnaethom adnabod trychfilod wrth drochi yn y pwll ac aethom ar helpa drychfilod gan eu grwpio. Roedd hi'n braf iawn cerdded o amgylch y parc a darllen am yr holl adar sy'n byw yno. Roedd hi'n ddiwrnod hamddenol ond addysgiadol iawn.



Following our topic work on *Pond Dipping*, Year 3 went on an exciting trip to Llanelli Wetland Centre. We had opportunities to take part in activities while observing wildlife. We identified insects during pond dipping and went on a bug hunt, grouping the different insects we found. It was lovely to walk around the park and read about all the birds that live there. It was a relaxing but a very informative day.



Blwyddyn 4

Mae Blwyddyn 4 wedi cael hanner tymor prysur iawn wrth ddechrau ein thema newydd, 'Plymio'r Pwll'. Rydym wedi ymchwilio i frogaod a'u cylch bywyd, gan ddysgu am yr anifeiliaid sy'n byw mewn pyllau ac yn ymweld â nhw, yn ogystal ag astudio amffibiaid. Cawsom ymweliad cyffrous â Phenclacwydd, lle cafodd y plant gyfle i archwilio'r amgylchedd naturiol a dysgu mwy am fywyd pyllau. Yn ystod ein gweithgareddau creadigol, mae'r disgyblion wedi creu eu pyllau eu hunain ar Minecraft ac wedi peintio pyllau hardd gan ddefnyddio dyfrliwiau.



Year 4 have had a very busy half term starting our new theme, 'Plymio'r Pwll'. We have researched frogs and their life cycle, learning about the animals that live in and visit ponds, as well as studying amphibians. We also enjoyed an exciting visit to Penclacwydd, where the children had the opportunity to explore the natural environment and learn more about pond life. During our creative activities, the pupils created their own ponds on Minecraft and painted beautiful pond scenes using watercolours. Everyone has thoroughly enjoyed the theme and shown great enthusiasm in their learning.



Y Cyngor Eco

Hoffem ddiolch yn fawr i'r holl ddisgyblion, teuluoedd a staff sydd wedi gwneud ymdrech arbennig i wneud newidiadau bach ond pwysig i'w taith i'r ysgol. Boed hynny'n cerdded, sgwtera, beicio neu barcio ymhellach i ffwrdd, mae pob cam yn helpu i greu arferion iachach, ffyrdd mwy diogel ac amgylchedd gwyrddach i'n cymuned.

The Eco Council has been proudly supporting the *Camau Bach / Camau Mawr* Walk to School Challenge across the school. Members of the Council have been visiting each classroom every day to collect and record travel data so that we can celebrate the results together at the end of the week. 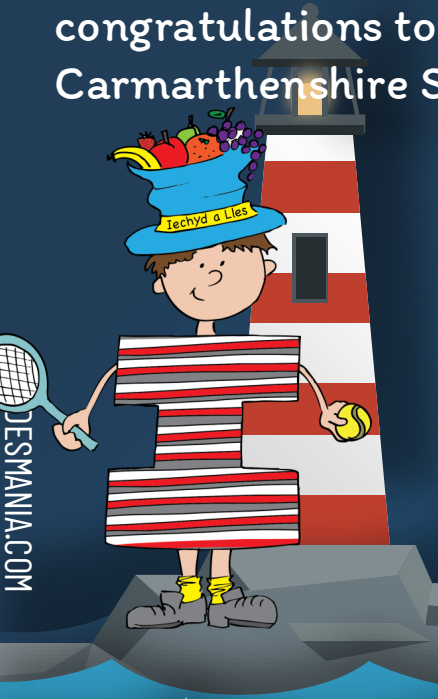
